What we do in Nursery...

Here at Beechwood Childcare, we endeavour to make our environment as welcoming as possible, and keep your children healthy, happy and safe.

We use the Early Years Foundation Stage to help monitor your child's development whilst they are with us, and aim for them to become **'School Ready'** by the time they leave. We do daily activities with the children which are influenced by their interests and areas of learning that need some support. We also allow them the freedom of **'child initiated play'** choosing what they would like, and who they would like to play with.

We believe that play based learning is one of the most important things with children of this age, and use different methods to encourage this.

We now include **'Forest School'** as a teaching method for our children, and encourage them to do a lot of their learning outside. Here they learn to develop an interest in the environment, and take care of their surroundings, whilst learning in an exciting, proactive approach.

We try to interact with our local community as much as possible, with us taking regular trips to the local library, and parks.



What we do in our Clubs ...

We run a very popular Before and After School Club, which caters for the children who attend Burman Infant School.

We work very closely with our school and find this to have a positive impact on the children as we are able to maintain a level of consistency between the settings.

During these sessions, children are allowed to relax and have a break from the structure of school. We do encourage daily activities, but allow the children to pick the things that we do, working as a team to decide what we will do the following week. Children here are also encouraged to create their own goals and boundaries that everyone is expected to follow, so that children develop a sense of ownership and belonging within the setting.

We run a holiday club in all of the holidays, except for a period over Christmas. All children from 3 - 11 years of age are welcome.

During holidays we usually plan themed weeks, with lots of fun activities included, and often (when ratios allow), we take trips out of the setting.



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
